- The student will not necessarily be judged on highest academic standing but must demonstrate commitment and motivation to succeed. Good citizenship, involvement in school activities, and a spirit of community volunteering is required. To collect the award the recipient must submit proof of registration and a copy of receipt of payment of tuition.
- The student is also asked to attend an Elks meeting in early September to receive the award.
- Award must be claimed within one calendar year from June 15 of the year presented unless prior agreement has been reached.
