Code of Conduct Agreement (2026–2027)

At Kw'yeqel Secondary, we work together to create a school that is safe, caring, respectful, and inclusive. We believe every student matters and deserves to feel a sense of belonging. This agreement reflects School District 33 Administrative Procedure 321: Student Code of Conduct and supports the shared responsibility of students, staff, and families to maintain a safe, caring, and inclusive school community. We follow the BC Human Rights Code and do not accept discrimination of any kind.

As a member of this school community, I agree to take care of myself and my learning. I will attend school regularly, arrive on time, come ready to learn, try my best, and use kind and respectful language. If attendance or lateness becomes a concern, staff will work with me and my parent/caregiver/guardian to understand barriers, identify supports, and help me re-engage with learning.

I agree to treat others with respect. I will be kind, inclusive, and welcoming. I understand that bullying, harassment, discrimination, and harmful language can hurt others and are not acceptable. I will try to solve problems in peaceful ways and ask for help when I need it. I respect that everyone has the right to learn without distractions.

I agree to take care of our learning environment. I will respect school property and the belongings of others. I will use personal devices and school technology in safe, respectful, and responsible ways. I will protect the privacy of others, communicate respectfully online, and will not take, share, or post photos, videos, or personal information without permission.

I understand that vaping, smoking, alcohol, drugs, weapons, and dangerous items are not allowed at school, on school property, during school-sponsored activities, or while representing the school in the community.

I will dress in a way that supports a safe, respectful, and inclusive learning environment. Dress expectations will be applied respectfully, equitably, and without shaming or discrimination.

I understand that my choices affect myself and others. I will help keep our school safe by reporting unsafe situations. I know I represent my school in the community and on field trips, and I will act responsibly. I also understand that I am still learning and can ask for support when I need it.
